A plot fee of \$45 for a full plot (4' by 8')/\$25 for a half plot (4' by 5') is required before the plot can be assigned.
This fee will go toward expenses of the community garden (water bills, community tools, reserve fund, etc.)

A clean up deposit of \$25 for a full plot (4' by 8')/\$10 for a half plot (4' by 5') is required before the plot can be assigned. The clean up deposit will be returned in the fall after you have removed all your plants and cleaned your plot.

Mandatory meetings. There will be a series of meetings/work days throughout the gardening season to help with the maintenance of the garden. Please see the attached list of Garden events for 2017. If you attend the mandatory meeting, and three hours on the work day or the weeding days, you will get the option to keep your garden plot for the 2018 garden season. If you do not meet this requirement, your name will go back on the waiting list and keeping your garden plot will not be guaranteed.

I acknowledge that I have read the list of meetings for the 2017 gardening season, and that I must attend all required meetings/work days or provide a proxy to attend, if I want to guarantee keeping my plot for next year.
