A plot fee of \$45 for a full plot (4' by 8')/\$25 for a half plot (4' by 5') is required before the plot can be assigned.
This fee will go toward expenses of the community garden (water bills, community tools, reserve fund, etc.)

A clean up deposit of \$20 for a full plot (4' by 8')/\$10 for a half plot (4' by 5') is required for new gardeners before the plot can be assigned. The clean up deposit will be returned when you give up your plot provided you have removed all your plants and tidied your plot.

Expected participation in running of the garden. There will be a series of meetings/work days throughout the gardening season to help with the maintenance of the garden (see the attached list of Garden events for 2019). Attendance at the kick-off meeting, and three hours on the work days is expected (you may send a proxy).

I acknowledge that I have read the list of meetings for the 2019 gardening season, and that I must participate in the running of the community garden if I want to guarantee keeping my plot for next year.
